The Houston Area OSHA Offices would like to cordially invite you to attend the Workers Memorial Day to honor and remember workers who have tragically lost their life in the workplace.

It is estimated that in 1970 around 14,000 workers were killed on the job. The number fell to approximately 4,340 in 2009. The rise in safety in the workplace began on April 28, 1971, when the Occupational Safety and Health Administration was formed to administer workplace standards under the Occupational Safety and Health Act.
